第一天 吉隆坡 ~ 新千岁

酒店: 千岁酒店/ 同级

集合于吉隆坡国际机场,然后乘搭客机飞往新千岁机场经成田国际机场。

第二天 新千岁~登别

(早/午/温泉酒店宴会料理) 酒店:洞爷湖太阳宫酒店/同级

- **登别海洋公园**-是一座有着北欧城堡风格的海洋公园,外观模仿耶斯克城堡为蓝图兴建,内部以展示北方海洋生物为主。水晶塔里主要展出的是拿破仑鱼。漫步在水底隧道可以眺望周围穿梭来往的大小不一的各种鱼类,简直就像在海底散步一样。
- **洞爷湖** 支笏洞爷国立公园。是一个风景绮丽的火山口湖,即使在冬季湖面也不会结冰。春夏秋冬,四季湖光山色,犹如仙境。湖畔有著名的洞爷湖温泉.也是北海道的温泉胜地之一。
- **昭和熊牧场** 牧场里饲养着 100 头左右的大小棕熊。新鲜的红苹果和饼干是它们的食物,游客可以和棕熊们来个亲密接触。这些可爱的熊己经非常适应人类了,还会撒娇卖荫,带给您回味无穷的开心体验。
- **昭和新山** 洞爷湖南岸的昭和新山,是 1943 年几次地震后由平底隆起的活火山,现海拔达 400 多米,远眺山口,终日白烟滚滚,是日本最年轻的山脉之一。

第三天 登别~定山溪(早/午/温泉酒店宴会料理)酒店:定山溪温泉酒店/定山溪格兰温泉酒店/同级

- **札幌啤酒工厂**-是日本具代表性的啤酒生产企业之一。
- 支笏湖 有"火山博物馆"之称的支笏国立公园坐落于北海道西南半岛的尖端,这里湖畔种有北海道特有的各种林木、风景优美。
- **佐々木观光果树园** 全年四季都能品赏到不同季节的水果,还可以探索那文明海外的四季风光。您也可以在这自然採水果的体验。

第四天 定山溪~札幌

(早/午/晚餐)

酒店: 札幌蒙特利酒店/ 同级

- **小樽运河** 北海道惟一的最古老的运河,曾作为港口的运输水道,经过精心的规划,小樽由原来的小渔村,变身成为今天浪漫的旅游观光圣地,运河也是小樽最具代表性的景点之一。
- 小樽罗曼蒂克街 集中了包含北一哨子玻璃饰品和音乐博物馆,著名的北果楼,六花亭的各式巧克力和精美甜点,北国风情的咖啡馆等,营造出小樽独特的浪漫气氛。
- **北一哨子馆** 最具规模也最有历史的玻璃工坊。它创立于 1901 年,制作工艺精巧绝伦。各式晶莹剔透的玻璃工艺品为小樽更添梦幻绽纷的色彩。
- **音乐盒博物馆** 是到访小樽必游的景点之一,光是展览馆内的音乐盒就超过三千件,还包括了极具收藏价值的洋娃娃音乐盒以及自动演奏的音乐盒等,造型精美,趣致可爱。
- **小樽天狗山缆车** 园瞪着眼,大长鼻子的天狗是日本的神圣人物,而在小樽市街后的天狗山就因为山形长得像天狗而得名;这里因为可以俯瞰小樽和小樽港而成为观光客必到的地方。在这里可以品尝到小樽特有的福給鱼套餐。
- 北海道神宫 -是北海道最具代表性的神宫。樱花季节和秋季,这里也是赏樱和赏枫的美丽景点。
- **薄野** 札幌市中央区著名的不夜城,与东京新宿的歌舞伎町及九州福冈的中州被列为"日本三大夜场",又称"簿野不夜天"。
- 拉面横町 北海道著名的拉面都汇聚于这里的各式拉面小店铺,您可以品尝到 道地的札幌拉面。

第五天 札幌

(早/午/晚餐) 酒店:千岁机场航站楼大酒店/同级

- <u>白色恋人 Chocolate Factory</u> –白色恋人象征着北海道长达半年的皑皑白雪和对爱人的期待,在此可以购买到著名白色恋人巧克力和精美甜点,还有展示巧克力发展史和制作过程的巧克力博物馆。这个洋溢着英伦气息的欧式古典城堡同时也是一个梦幻的游乐园。
- **狸小路** 札幌市中心最大商店街,共分七个玻璃天棚的街区。这条街的历史可追溯到明治时期,不但带给你逛街乐趣,也是选购土产和各式手信的好地方。
- <u>三井 OUTLET</u> –规模高达约 133 店于 2009 年,它成为日本西部最大的购物中心。 关于其尺寸许多受欢迎的商店和季节性知名品牌在国内和国外,女装,男装,当然,处理品牌也摆放着各种各样的产品,可孩子们,户外,运动,室内,杂货,以满足需要广泛的客户。

第六天 札幌~占冠

(早/午/晩餐)

酒店: 星野 TOMAMU 度假村/ 同级

- 富良野-(薰衣草赏花季节,6月下旬-7月上旬)-富田农场为北海道最先驱的花田之一。原仅栽植薰衣草的富田农场,在主人的精心打理下渐渐地成为今日所见的彩虹花海。薰衣草外,来到这里你还可看到法国金盏花、罂粟花、羽扁豆花等多种花朵。您也可以在这体验薰衣草枕头制作体验。
- <u>旭川公園</u> 为纪念札幌市建市 100 周年而于 1970 年建成开放的公园。站在海拔 137.5 米高的展望台上,石狩平原、日本海、札幌市 区尽收眼底。尤其是在夜晚,饰灯齐放的喷水,以及远处札幌市中心的办公大楼的灯光。公园里修建有散步道,此外,还建有休息 屋、吊桥、玩具广场、幼儿乐园等,白天不仅可以在大自然中散步,幼小的孩子们也可以在这里玩各种各样的玩具。
- **夕张由仁花园** 在一派田园风光的由仁町中,由仁花园显得格外艳丽夺目。一年四季风景各异。春天以樱花开始,初夏有 102 万支柳穿鱼,夏末有百合,秋天有大波斯菊,鲜花盛开,甚为壮观。同时,这里还有种类丰富的香草,游人散步时可以用手捏捏。
- <u>十胜山</u>—位于连峰的中央位置,也是连峰中最高峰的十胜山连峰,拥有亚寒带森林,是以雄伟山岳美而自豪的北海道的屋脊,大雪山国立公园的一部分。

Day 01 Kuala Lumpur ~ Chitose

Hotel: Hotel Chitose / SML

Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for your flight to Hokkaido via Narita.

Day 02 Chitose ~ Noboribetsu

(B/L/Hotel Banquet Buffet) Hotel: Toya Sun Palace Spa Hotel / SML

- Noboribetsu Marine Park This theme park is modeled after Egeskov Castle in Denmark and designed to project a Scandinavian and European image. The parks main attraction is a marine ecology hall which houses an array of sea life.
- Lake Toya is a volcanic caldera lake; also an ice-free lake. It never freezes, even in winter when the temperature falls quite drastically.
- Showa Bear Ranch The ranch rear about 100 bears. You can buy bear treats and feed the bears through slots in the cage. The bears are very intelligent and beat on the glass to get your attention and treats.
- Showa Shinzan is a volcanic lava dome formed in 1943 after a few volcano eruption in the Shikotsu-Toya National Park and the height of this volcano is 400 meters above sea level.

Day 03 Noboribetsu ~ Jozankei (B/L/Hotel Banquet Buffet)

Hotel: Jozankei Spa Hotel / Jozankei Grand Spa Hotel / SML

- <u>Sapporo Beer Garden</u> Is one of Japan's popular beer production enterprises.
- Lake Shikotsuko is a caldera lake in Chitose, Hokkaido. It is a part of the Shikotsu-Toya National Park.
- Yamamoto Fruit Farm Yamamoto Orchard is located in Yoichi town, Hokkaido, at the North side of Japan. You can enjoy picking fruit experience at here.

Day 04 Jozankei ~ Sapporo (B/L/D) Hotel: Hotel Monterey Sapporo / SML

- Otaru Canal was a central part of the city's busy port in the first half of the 20th century. The cargoes from large vessels were unloaded by smaller ships, which then transported the goods to warehouses along the canal.
- Otaru Handicraft Street Glass handicraft shop, music box shop, museum, art gallery, ice-cream shop, souvenirs and more.
- <u>Kitaichi Glass Otaru</u> It has a workshop where the manufacturing process can be observed and visitors can experience glass creation.
- Music Box Musuem Otaru is well known for beautiful and intricate music boxes. A museum that contains exhibits about the development of
 music boxes, a collection of several notable music boxes, as well as an extensive store that carries many different types.
- Otaru Tenguyama Ropeway is Japanese aerial lift line in Otaru, Hokkaidō, operated by Chūō Bus Kankō Shōji. The company also operates
 bus terminals, Sapporo Municipal Subway kiosks, and ski resorts. Opened in 1979, the line climbs Mount Tengu with the panoramic view of the
 city
- <u>Hokkaido Shrine</u> is the most notable Hokkaido Shrine.
- Susukino is a red-light district in Chūō-ku, Sapporo. It is one of the three major red-light districts in Japan along with Kabukichō, Tokyo, and Nakasu, Fukuoka. Currently, the district is congested with many restaurants, bars, hotels, and adult-entertainment establishments.
- Ramen Yokocho Ramen is a noodle for Japanese people, and "Sapporo ramen" is one of the three major ramens in Japan.

Day 05 Sapporo

(B/L/D) Hotel: Chitose Air Terminal Hotel / SML

- Shiroi Koibito Chocolate Factory Shiroi Koibito Park is a fantastic space based on the ideals of deliciousness, fun and stories of sweets from a bygone era. In addition to housing the Shiroi Koibito Factory where this well-known Hokkaido confectionery is produced.
- Tanuki Koji It consists of a long cover street that runs all the way from West 1 at the Soseigawa River Park to West 7, which is closed to vehicle traffic.
- <u>MITSUI OUTLET</u> the outlet park features approximately 130 stores from famous foreign and domestic brands offering women's, men's and kid's fashion, sporting and outdoor goods, fashion items, lifestyle items and more.

Day 06 Sapporo ~ Shimukappu (B/L/D) Hotel: Hoshino Resorts Tomamu / SML

- <u>Furano</u> (Lavender season; end of June to Mid July) Furano has beautiful summer season where you can see the beautiful colors of nature everywhere. You can also experience the lavender pillows produced here.
- <u>Asahikawa Park</u> Asahikawa Park is to commemorate the 100th anniversary of Sapporo City that builds in 1970 year. You can view the
 Ishikariheigen Country Club, the Sea of Japan, Sapporo City panoramic view from the platform that are 137.5 meters high. Besides, it also has
 marina, rest house, drawbridge, toy square, children parks and so on.
- Yuni Garden The colorful Yuni Garden is located in the pastoral neighborhood of Yuni-cho located approximately one hour south of Sapporo by car. Lilies blossom at the end of the summer and cosmos fill the garden in the fall. The garden also features many herbs, which visitors can touch and smell as they walk through the garden.
- Tokachi Mountain the central and highest mountain range, The mountains are covered with subarctic forest such as Jezo spruce and Japanese pine, and the mountain range is part of Taisetsuzan National Park, the "roof of Hokkaido", whose magnificent mountains are one of Hokkaido's proudest attractions.
