# 7天6晚 北京·大同

**第一天 吉隆坡  香港 ~ 北京 (晚餐)** 住：北京驿府酒店/同级  
 准时前往吉隆坡国际机场离境大厅指定航空公司柜台集合，办理登机手续后，乘豪华客机飞往中国首都 - 北京。之后送往酒店休息。

**第二天 北京 (早/午/晚餐)** 住：北京驿府酒店/同级  
**外观国家大剧院：**以建筑规模而言，国家大剧院已跻身世界超大型剧院行列，其设施条件居世界一流水准，与国际著名大剧院并驾齐驱，  
**天安门广场：**位于明清故宫皇城的南门，于市区中心北京中轴线上。坐落在广场的北端，五星红旗在广场上空高高飘扬；人民英雄纪念碑屹立在广场的中央；人民大会堂和中国国家博物馆在广场的东西两侧遥遥相对；毛主席纪念堂和正阳门城楼矗立在广场的南部  
**故宫 - 也称紫禁城，**是中国古代皇帝执政居住的地方。位于北京市中心、天安门广场北面、景山南门对面，世界上规模最大的宫殿建筑群。故宫可以分为两大部分，南为工作区，即外朝，北为生活区，即内廷。外朝内廷的所有建筑排列在中轴线上，东西对称，秩序井然。

**第三天 北京~大同 (早/午/晚餐)** 住：美晶酒店/同级  
**居庸关长城：**体会不登长城非好汉的感觉。长城全长 6000 多公里，是世界上最伟大的建筑之一。长城始建于秦始皇时期，经过历代的增补修筑，现在能看到的长城几乎都是明代所建。  
**大同：**山西省第二大城市，素有“煤都”和“凤凰城”之称的大同 [车程约 4 小时]。  
**外观古城墙 -**修建于明洪武五年，城墙高大雄伟，坚固险峻，布防严密，设施完善，是我国古代军事建筑史上颇具特色的重镇名城  
**华严寺广场 -**是大同古城修复建设中古街道改造建成的风格一体的旅游特色步行街

**第四天 大同 ~ 北京 (早/午/晚餐)** 住：世园凯悦酒店/同级  
**云冈石窟 (不含电瓶车)：**联合国教科文组织列为世界文化遗产，中国四大石窟之一。云冈石窟距今已有 1500 多年的历史，始建于公元 460 年，由当时的佛教高僧昙曜奉旨开凿。此石窟依山而凿，东西绵延约一公里，气势恢弘，内容丰富。现存主要洞窟 45 个，大小窟龕 252 个，造像 5 万 1 千余尊，代表了公元 5 至 6 世纪时中国杰出的佛教石窟艺术。  
**悬空寺：**此寺建于 1400 年前北魏后期，是中国仅存的佛、道、儒三教合一的独特寺庙。悬空寺原来叫“玄空阁”，「玄」取自於中国传统宗教道教教理，「空」则来源于佛教的教理，后来改名为悬空寺，是因为整座寺院就像悬挂在悬崖之上，在汉语中，「悬」和「玄」同音，因此得名。。殿宇嵯峨。

**第五天 北京 (早/午/-)** 住：米佳国际酒店/同级  
**天坛 -**中国现代最大坛庙建筑之天坛，它乃明、清两代帝王祀天祈谷的坛庙，天坛建筑布局呈“回”字形，由两道坛墙分成内坛、外坛两大部分。最南的围墙呈方型，象征地，最北的围墙呈半圆型，象征天，北高南低，这既表示天高地低，又表示“天圆地方”  
**前门仿古大街 -** 修复后的前门大街两侧的商业建筑多为清末民初的低层建筑风格。除了建筑风格的回归，恢复被看做是复兴传统的另一表现  
**老北京劝业场 -** 结合了老北京近 50 栋新旧建筑组成的建筑群。最大限度地保护和重塑本地块的历史原貌，展现京城古韵与时尚的碰撞。  
**Page One 图书馆 -** 皇城根脚下的这间，规模之大品种之多，室内设计之精美，环境之卓越，地段之优良，都真真能让来的人逛上一整天。  
**全球最大星巴克旗舰店 -** 作为星巴克打造第三空间的最新精湛之作，北京坊旗舰店集星巴克臻选、茶瓦纳™ 和特调学派三大整层独立空间于  
**世贸天阶天幕 -** 位列美国拉斯维加斯之后，为亚洲首座，是世界上最先进的高新媒体之一。这座天幕为整条商业街带来富于梦幻色彩和时尚品位的声光组合，成为一座吸引人潮的世界级奇观一体

**第六天 北京 (早/午/-)** 住：米佳国际酒店/同级  
**颐和园 (不含游船) -** 原名清漪园，始建于公元 1750 年，时值中国最后一个封建盛世“康乾盛世”时期；1860 年的第二次鸦片战争中，清漪园被英法联军烧毁，1886 年清政府挪用海军军费等款项重修，并于两年后改名颐和园，作为慈禧太后晚年的颐养之地。  
**什刹海 -** 古典与现代相容，传统与前卫契合，自然景观与人文胜迹辉映的老北京景区  
**外观国家体育场“鸟巢” -** 国家体育场在奥运会期间设有 10 万个座位，承办该届奥运会的开幕式、闭幕式，以及田径足球等比赛项目，由于造型独特又俗称“鸟巢”  
**国家游泳中心“水立方” -** 国家游泳中心因表面看如一个装满水的立方体所以俗称“水立方”，为奥运主要的水上项目比赛场馆  
**“盘古大观” -** 盘古大观国际公寓，像一条白色巨龙一样横亘在鸟巢、水立方这些著名的奥运场馆旁，与后者仅一路之隔。北京唯一一家七星级酒店  
**外观东便门城楼 -** 明朝嘉靖四十三年（1564 年），为了防御蒙古骑兵的骚扰，增强北京城的防卫，保障北京城的安全，修筑了包围南郊一面的外城，在外城的最东端修建了东便门。在当时的形势下，统治者最强烈的愿望是安宁，安宁压倒一切。  
**王府井大街 + 小吃街 -** 北京市中心著名的商业大街，自由购物 + 品尝道地小吃。  
**车游长安街 -** 乘车游览北京著名的国宾大街夜景

**DAY 1 KUALA LUMPUR  HONG KONG~BEIJING (D)** **Hotel : Beijing YiFu Hotel / SML**  
 Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for your flight to the capital of China, Beijing. Arrival Beijing in midnight, transfer to hotel.

**DAY 2 BEIJING ( B/L/D )** **Hotel : Beijing YiFu Hotel / SML**  
**View National Grand Theater** - Based on the building itself, this magnificent Theater is already one of the largest theater in the world. Especially the facilities in the theater, comparable to those world famous theater.  
**Tian'an Men Square** - is located at the heart of Beijing, is the largest urban square in the world. Beside the square are Great Hall of the People and China National Museum. In the center stands The Monument Of the People's Heroes and Chairman Mao memorial Hall.  
**Forbidden City** - Zijincheng (also known as The Imperial Palace, and The Palace Museum) is the largest and best preserved collection of ancient buildings in China. The complex is divided into two sections: the Inner Court or the living quarters, and the working area also known as Outer Court.

**DAY 3 BEIJING~ DATONG ( B/L/D )** **Hotel : MeiJing Hotel / SML**  
**JuYong Pass Great Wall** - is a series of stone and earthen fortifications in China, built, rebuilt, and maintained between the 5th century BC and the 16th century to protect the northern borders of the Chinese Empire from Xiongnu attacks during the rule of successive dynasties. Till today it has been a symbolic achievement of the Chinese people.  
**Datong - 2nd largest city in Shanxi Province, popular known as "coal city" and "phoenix city".**  
**View Datong city wall** - The ancient city wall of Datong was built in Ming Hongwu 5th year. The wall are majestic. They are rugged and steeply guarded, well-known town in the history of ancient Chinese military architecture.  
**Huayan Temple Square** - It is a reconstructed of the ancient Datong streets, a very unique walking streets.

**DAY 4 DATONG ~BEIJING ( B/L/D )** **Hotel : Hyatt Regency Hotel / SML**  
**Yungang Grottoes** (exclude buggy car). UNESCO World Heritage Site, one of the four famous Buddhist stone .sculpture sites in China. It is an outstanding example of the Chinese stone carving cave from 5th and 6th centuries. All together the site is composed of 252 grottoes with more than 51,000 Buddha statues  
**Hanging Monastery** - It is built more than 1,400 years ago; this temple is notable not only for its location on a sheer precipice but also because it includes Buddhist, Taoist, and Confucian elements. The structure is kept in place with wooden crossbeams fitted into holes chiseled into the cliffs. The main supportive structure was hidden .

**DAY 5 BEIJING ( B/L/ - )** **Hotel : Mijia International Hotel / SML**  
**Temple of Heaven** - The Temple buildings and the parklands reflect ancient Chinese religious beliefs that imagine heaven as round and earth as square. Thus, the buildings in the temple are constructed on a central axis. The temples themselves are round and the bases square.  
**Qianmen Street** - This street is restoring its streetscape to early twentieth century, showing the face of "Old Beijing".  
**Beijing QuanYe Chang** - combined old Beijing 50 old and new buildings, it represents the preserved culture and new capital city atmosphere.  
**Page One Book Store** - with beautiful decoration and good locations, this is one of the largest Library.  
**Starbucks Flag Ship Store** - This Flag Ship Store is the World largest.  
**The Place** - with length 250 meters, width 30 meters, it consists of unique and elegant shopping Mall and Pedestrian Street.

**DAY 6 BEIJING ( B/L/ - )** **Hotel : Mijia International Hotel / SML**  
**Summer Palace** . - This palace originally called 'Qingyi Garden', like most of the gardens of Beijing, it could not elude the rampages of the Anglo-French allied force and was destroyed by fire. In 1886, Empress Dowager Cixi embezzled navy funds to reconstruct it for her own benefit, changing its name to Summer Palace (Yiheyuan). She spent most of her later years there, dealing with state affairs and entertaining.  
**ShaChaHai** - classic and modern, traditional and advance combined, it is the distinguish spot in old Beijing.  
**"Bird Nest"** - the 100,000 seats, 2008 Olympic Games National Stadium . Due to unique structure, thus it was called "Bird Nest".  
**Aquatics "Water Cube"** - National Swimming Center, outer structure looks like, water fill cube, thus named "Water Cube".  
**View Pangu Plaza** - like a white dragon crossing over the Bird Nest and Water Cube, the only seven star hotel in Beijing.  
**View Dongbianmen City Wall** - it was built in 1564, to defend the Mongolian army attacks, strengthen the defense of Beijing city.  
**Wangfujing Street** - one of the biggest shopping area in Beijing and you can try the local delicacies.  
**Night tour in Changan Street by coach** -
